Footnotes

DOUBLE SHOTGUN raced up close from the start, stalked racing three wide down the backside, moved up and vied for the lead past the quarter pole, took over from a stubborn LUCKY DRUMMER mid stretch, was kept to task holding safe. RAYWICK well placed throughout while saving ground, angled out mid stretch, finished willingly. LUCKY DRUMMER sent early, held a narrow advantage racing in the two path, had the rail turning for home, fought hard to deep stretch, ceded stubbornly in a very game effort. CHOCOLATE KNIGHT unhurried and trailed in the early going, saved ground around the bend, surged late to finish with interest. PATTON PENDING was hard used from the gate, raced out four to five wide for the run down the backside, chased under urging at the quarter pole, lacked late kick, was outfinished for minor awards. STASH THE BOOTS settled in the second flight, asked mid turn, came five wide into the stretch, lacked late kick, no late threat. ROJO DE AMOUR lacked speed, trailed around the second turn, failed to menace. TROOPER THORN unhurried, traveled four to five wide throughout, roused to no avail, never factored. MANGIARACINA sent hard, battled for the lead to mid turn, took a bad step entering the stretch and was quickly pulled up, rider dismounted in upper stretch.
