Footnotes

INFINITE GLORY rushed up to vie for the lead going down the backside, put away SCOTTIE entering the stretch, raced in the three path from upper stretch, drew off being ridden out. TRUTHSAYER settled early, raced along the rail throughout, rallied from mid stretch, got up late securing the place position. GOOD SAMARITAN tracked racing off the rail, rallied near the quarter pole, duelled for the place position racing between rivals, was outgamed in last strides, settled for third best. KYLE'S TREASURY was forwardly placed, bid four wide chasing the winner entering the stretch, vied abreast rivals inside the furlong marker for a minor placing, needed more late. SCOTTIE broke alertly, pressed INFINITE GLORY down the backside, began to chase leaving the quarter pole, had little left with a furlong to go. HIS NAME WAS RICO trailed to the quarter pole, raced along the rail in the stretch run, improved position but never threatened. YOYO JABO raced evenly traveling at mid track, roused to no avail, failed to menace. CELTIC FIRE lacked speed, varied little, no factor. MONO RIDGE was hustled early to race in mid pack, retreated leaving the quarter pole, no factor in the stretch. JUDGE LOUIE lacked speed, angled to the rail shortly after the start, faded mid turn, no factor.
