SOME KINDA TROUBLE dueled briefly for the early lead, was smartly taken back to stalk entering the backstretch, sat patient to midway on the second turn, quickly gained traveling three wide coming to the quarter pole, drove clear in upper stretch, raced off the rail deep stretch, was kept to pressure holding safe. MERLIN BAY rated early and saved ground to the three eighths pole, angled out at the quarter pole, bid three wide top of the lane, angled inside at the sixteenth pole, surged strongly nearing the wire, missed in a hard effort. BONNISTAR hustled from the gate, battled for the lead running along the inside, fought hard to upper stretch, tired late holding the show position in a good try. OUTRIDERS POSSE settled towards the rear, roused angling five wide upper stretch, mildly bid but was no real threat. SIR DEPUTY unhurried leaving the gate, trailed down the backside, made a bold move at the quarter pole, hung late being outfinished for a minor award. WILLIE BAGS raced three to four wide into the first turn, pressed the pace to the far turn, started to drop off past the quarter pole, used up. GAME PLAY'S ICON showed brief early speed dueling racing between rivals, could not keep pace at the five eighths pole, stopped at the quarter pole, finished being eased across the finish line. THE RIDER OF MERLIN BAY CLAIMED FOUL AGAIONST THE RIDER OF SOME KINDA TROUBLE FOR INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH, AFTER REVIEWING THE TAPE, THE SWETARDS DISMISSED THIS CLAIM, RESULTS STOOD AS IS.
