Footnotes

SICILIAN BOY unhurried while saving ground responded on the far turn passing tiring rivals then angling out to take aim in upper stretch, found best stride late surging to grab LIQUOREUX on the wire. LIQUOREUX sent clear from the break set a solid pace through the far turn, hooked from the outside by AKEBONO in upper stretch proved determined turning that one back only to denied by a hard closing SICILLIAN BOY in the last jump. AKEBONO stalked evenly rallying to bid on the far turn, bore down abreast LIQUOREUX in upper stretch, would waver under stiff urging ceding late. DAKOTA FREEWAY rated early gave a mild response to upper stretch mustering enough to outbid the others. UNO WAY CALLE slow early gained contention on the turn extended to upper stretch would come up a bit short. BROOKLIME (IRE) lost ground moving up to the far turn, would flatten out in upper stretch. I PLAN TO GO sent early was tucked inside on the backstretch then gave way on the far turn. PARKER VALLEY stalked the pace looming through the far turn, would wilt at mid track in upper stretch. CLASSIC RUNAWAY rushed wide early would fold up on the far turn.
