YOU'RE MY BOY BLUE unhurried early drew closer on the turn, bid four deep in upper stretch edging up in the closing yards. TUFFY COTTRELL hustled out pressured the pace from between horses through the turn, dueled in the two path down the stretch ceding grudgingly late. CHALLENGER chased along the inside through the turn, extending near the rail battled late being outfinished. CITIZEN WEST broke sharply pressuring the pace through the turn, dueled between horses in the three path upper stretch before wearing down late. SNOWBOARD RIDGE a step slow early drew closer as the field bunched on the turn, came six wide in upper stretch proving no menace. SNOW MON chased the pace through the turn then wore down near mid track in upper stretch. SOUND THE CHARGE chased early pressing up to challenge on the turn, gave way in upper stretch.
