THE BIG WHAMMY broke alertly pressuring the pace on a short lead to upper stretch, dueled inside of foe down the lane battling to the end. BAGATELLE TERRACE pressed inside early then chased on the turn, angled out to mid track in upper stretch would hang late. PRIZE FEVER reared up then ducked out at the break, raced very wide throughout. FLOWER GIRL slow early rushed up four wide on the turn then leveled off in upper stretch. JENNY REDI MADE broke slowly, raced evenly to upper stretch failing to menace inside. BOOK VALUE played no factor. WINTER RIDGE chased early then tired to upper stretch. SUNNY SIGHTS gave way on the turn.
