Footnotes

EVE HARRINGTON nicely rated, rallied 6 wide into the lane, drove clear deep stretch and won going away. CLASSY KAY stalked 3 wide, dueled into lane, led 1/16, was out finished late in a very game try. DYNA MOTION rated backside, rallied into lane, finished well between rivals too late. STOP SEVEN set pace, dueled along inside, game to mid stretch, came up a little short from early battle. FOR MIDGE tracked wide backside, bid 4 wide far turn, loomed in the lane, angled out wider in deep stretch but hung in final strides. PRINCESS EL well placed, saved ground, asked into stretch, came up empty. ANGEL SLIPPER 5 wide first turn, raced second flight, roused going into the far turn, had no rally. HOPE SOON hustled from gate, dueled 2 wide, weakened at top of lane. IMMEDIATE CHANCE raced wide throughout, was no factor. BLUSHING CALLER raced middle of pack, off rail, roused, had no response.
