SPIRIT TO RUN broke sharply nursing a short lead through the turn, shook clear in the three path upper stretch. BOBBIE'S DEVIL tracked evenly along the inside, angled three path upper stretch, saved place. DUTY ROSTER hustled out came six wide upper stretch, finished evenly. NEVEREVERYIELD slow early raced seven wide to upper stretch, improved position there. THE ONE TO CHASE saved ground playing no factor. GATO ESPACIAL hustled along came five wide upper stretch, weakened at mid track. FIDDLERS PRIDE slow early played no factor. BAIRDS VILLAGE sent hard pressed through the turn then wore out in upper stretch. THE FLYN'JACAMACOO took a bad step and was pulled up.
