STICK UP ARTIST broke alertly pressing to keep a head in front through the turn, dueling inside of MY JORDAN down the stretch dug deep prevailing gamely in the four path. MY JORDAN was bumped and jostled between horses after the break, hurried to join the pace pressured abreast STICK UP ARTIST through the turn dueling from mid track in upper stretch, extending late became a bit weary when ceding the issue. SWAYLON BRAYLON veered out bumping MY JORDAN after the break, tracked the pace while saving ground posing no real menace while hanging on to position. GOTTA RUNAWAY fractious in the gate was slow to break, raced evenly along the inside throughout. MIGHTY PRIZE was bumped and crowded after the break, played no factor. READY SET WHOA was never involved racing seven wide through the stretch. EZ PAY was always outrun.
