Footnotes

SICILIAN BOY nicely rated while saving ground down the backside, angled three wide to vie for the lead entering the stretch, edged away from TALIA'S CHOICE in deep stretch, won driving. TALIA'S CHOICE well placed early, bid on the turn, put a head in front top of the lane, vied racing between foes mid stretch, was out gamed by the winner coming to the wire, proved second best. QUASSAPAUG hustled from the gate, pressed PAT'S CAT from the start, gained a slight advantage far turn, battled to mid stretch, weakened and just saved the show position under an all out drive. HARAMA lacked speed, reserved to mid turn, angled to split foes upper stretch, closed belatedly but was no threat. PAT'S CAT sent hard, set a pressured pace running along the rail, began to give way leaving the quarter pole, used up. RAYWICK settled in the second flight, hard ridden mid turn, did improved placing late, no factor. NIGHTLIFEATBIGBLUE tracked the pace under a rating, roused while between foes at the quarter pole, lacked late response. NEWBURY outrun early, raced along the rail throughout, hard ridden into the stretch, failed to menace. THE STALKER hustled early, stalked then chased racing four wide down the backside, gave way leaving the quarter pole. BECKON THE KING was never involved racing wide throughout.
