Footnotes

CANADIAN HOME RUN pressed for the early lead, raced outside of ADVISE AND CONSENT down the backstretch, drew even on the bend, moved clear past the quarter pole, was kept to task increasing margin to the finish. ADVISE AND CONSENT hustled to the front, set a pressured pace racing along the rail, dueled with the winner mid turn, ceded by upper stretch proving no match, dug in nearing the wire under a stiff drive to save second place. KOKOMO GYPSY raced up close saving ground, angled out to the three path top of the lane mounting bid, never threatened the winner then was out noddod on the wire vying for second place. DOUBLE JUMP broke awkwardly breaking in to bump COMEBACK, was carried out near the seven eighths pole, settled in mid pack, rallied four wide at the quarter pole, leveled off mid stretch needing more late. ROAR TIGER ROAR rated and raced towards the rear traveling mid track, swung seven wide into the lane, showed belated action improving placing but never menaced. FRANCONA was outrun early, swung eight wide upper stretch, passed tiring rivals in the lane but never factored. CALL ME JUNIOR raced five wide into the first turn, was carried out wider at the seven eighths when GOLD AWARD took a bad step and was being eased, chased leaving the far turn, weakened top of the lane. COMEBACK was bumped form both sides at the break, carried out by GOLD AWARD at the seven eighths, raced four wide to the half, gave way past the quarter pole. HISTORIAN broke out, bumped, was quickly outrun, raced sluggishly, never involved. GOLD AWARD took a bad step at the seven eighths pole, drifted outward being eased, vanned off.
