Footnotes

RUNZEN broke alert wrestling then working a short lead through the turn, shook clear in upper stretch digging in near the rail holding on late. LALIQUE bumped at the break lost ground to upper stretch, responded in the seven path angling in a bit while closing under a hand ride just missing. WINK AT THE BOYS chased the pace through the turn, extending at mid track down the lane would weaken. CLIQUE away slowly was circled out to upper stretch gaining position seven wide. BRIGHTEST CRYSTAL bumped at the break chased and pressured the pace through the turn, would wear down in upper stretch. SAHMBA LA VISTA was always a step slow. SPRINGS BLING slow early was always outrun finishing seven wide. SEVEN TIGERS hopped missing the break, stayed back after finishing at mid track. BLACK MYSTIC chased early then gave way on the turn. WALTZING TIME bobbed slightly at the break, angled inside pursuing on the turn then wilted in upper stretch.
