Footnotes

SAVETHETANGOFORME stalked a pair of duelers saving ground, mounted bid angling three wide top of the lane taking aim, collared REESE'S ROAR mid stretch, drew off late under energetic handling. REESE'S ROAR was hard used early dueling with COLUMBIA CAT from the start, matched strides to top of the lane, disposed of that rival then was headed by SAVETHETANGOFORME mid stretch, caved in nearing the wire just holding on to second place. ANDY'S CHAMP lacked speed and trailed to mid turn, rallied splitting foes mid stretch, surged at the wire just missing second place in a game effort. DURANTS AFLEET settled early running towards the rear, found best stride mid stretch, made a big late run along the rail at the finish just missing out on a minor award. ACEINTHESKY settled in the second flight, raced four to five wide upper stretch, lacked needed punch besting rest. GOOD HARBOUR stalked early on, gave chase leaving the quarter pole running in the three path, failed to threaten and tired from mid stretch. CHIPCO settled in the second flight, swung widest racing six to seven wide in upper stretch, failed to respond. RUNFORGLORY flashed brief foot stalking to the quarter pole, began to fade in upper stretch. COLUMBIA CAT sent hard from the gate, went head to head with the runner up to top of the stretch, stopped mid stretch finishing weary.
