KANU well rated responded into the far turn reeling in STEPPEDOUTOFPLACE to grab the lead an eighth out, gradually edged away under steady handling. STEPPEDOUTOFPLACE broke alert measuring inside of FEEL THE FURY as the pair carried the pace to the far turn, shaking off rival to go clear there was overpowered from the outside by KANU in upper stretch, proving no match held well to secure place. DUBAI CITY away slowly gave a five wide move on the far turn advancing into upper stretch, widest late held others safe. AL FAASIL bumped at the break raced evenly off the pace to the half, gained along the inside cutting the corner to upper stretch, leveled off under a drive. REMEMBERINJONATHON stalked the pace racing five wide to the half, would fold up on the far turn. HONORING BLUE sluggish early failed to respond. ABBRONZATO struggled throughout. FEEL THE FURY hustled out prompting the pace, was used up on the far turn.
