Footnotes

PATSY'S COOKIN' broke alertly, was soon headed by WHERETHEWESTBEGINS, maintained slight advantage to mid turn, edged away near the quarter pole, was again threatened by that rival in upper stretch, repulsed that bid and held safe under steady handling. WHERETHEWESTBEGINS was off just a step slow, quickly rushed up along the rail to press PATSY'S COOKIN' for the lead, took back mid turn and angled out past the quarter pole, came again to challenge that rival in upper stretch, was turned away inside the eighth pole, proved a very game second best. D'DUPLICATE raced towards the inside around the bend, angled entering the stretch, moved back towards the inside mid stretch, mildly bid to improve placing. WILD PURSUIT was well placed from the start stalking a contested pace, put to a stiff drive top of the stretch, loomed to deep stretch, needed more and was outfinished in last strides vying for a minor placing. TEXPLOSIVE HALL moved to the rail shortly after the start, failed to menace despite being hard ridden. ALRIGHT NOW offered little racing at mid track. SHAMAN GOLD lacked speed, showed little never factoring.
