**Footnotes**

IT'S GOTTA BE US pressed for the lead soon after the start, dueled abreast running three wide mid turn, edged clear top of the lane, headed from both sides at the sixteenth pole, dug in under severe pressure and prevailed late being fully extended. GINGERS LADD settled in good tracking position, came four wide entering the stretch, drew even inside the eighth pole, vied abreast foes coming to the wire, was out noddied missing in a hard effort but won the head bob getting second place. TWICE WILD sent hard and alternated with IT'S GOTTA BE US soon after the start and around the bend, came again in deep stretch vying in a three way battle, was outfinished by top pair in last jumps, game effort. THREEWISEMEN lagged to the quarter pole, swung eight wide top of the stretch, found stride at the furlong marker, finished fastest of all coming to the wire but never menaced. MUSIC FAN was off a step slow, hustled to race in mid pack, swung six wide upper stretch, failed to respond. GIMMEAWINN raced up close to a contested pace saving ground, angled out five wide upper stretch, lacked kick despite being hard ridden. HE'S MY TUFF showed good speed and dueled to mid turn running between foes, began to tire in upper stretch, no late factor. SERVICE ACT settled in the second flight, saved ground throughout, failed to factor. LATIN SAILOR showed little racing mid track. DOCTOR SHOCK made a steady retreat from mid turn traveling along the rail, no factor.
