ORIENTAL BELLA sent clear set the pace traveling in hand on the backside, cut loose on the far turn angled from the two to the five path in mid stretch holding CREDIT CRUNCH at bay. CREDIT CRUNCH well rated was hard roused moving to contention on the far turn, circled out six wide in upper stretch loomed abreast ORIENTAL BELLA making no headway late. SHES THAT GOOD tracked the pace advancing to challenge in the three path upper stretch, extending the last eighth proved no match for outside rivals. ROYAL SNEAK went evenly through the backside cutting the corner to contention in upper stretch, all out along the rail would bog down late. CLASSIC CITY DIVA unhurried early angled five wide to upper stretch finishing evenly near mid track. BELOVEDA tracked the pace to the far turn, wavered there fading along the inside to upper stretch. TOP TOUCH was always outrun.
