SAINTS PRINCESS stalked a contested pace to mid turn, bid four wide vying for the lead at the quarter pole, dueled outside of TRUST ME T from top of the stretch, went head to head to the wire, won the bob in last jump being fully extended. TRUST ME T raced up close from the start, came thru narrow opening at the quarter pole, vied in a four way battle entering the stretch, edged clear mid stretch, held a head lead in deep stretch, was nosed out in last jump missing in a very determined effort. CARLOTA GARCIA (URU) settled nicely tracking a hotly contested pace, angled to the four path in upper stretch, put to a stiff drive mid stretch, was slowly inching closer to top pair coming to the wire, missed in a game effort. QUIET GIRL settled in the second flight, angled five wide upper stretch, improved placing but needed a bit more late. LADY VAN was hard used from the gate, battled around the bend traveling three wide and between foes at the quarter pole, began to weaken mid stretch, no late threat. LADY OF SONG was a step slow into stride, came six wide under a stiff drive top of the lane, failed to menace. TETON GOLD broke alertly, set a pressured pace to mid turn, battled to the three sixteenths, was all done a furlong out, faded to the finish. CIXI was quickly outrun, never involved.
