Footnotes

DIP MY BEAK settled along the rail stalking a pair of duelers, angled off to split foes near the quarter pole, battled in a three way duel entering the stretch, drew off under steady handling for a convincing victory. ASHORE prompted the pace from the start, almost drew even leaving the quarter pole, vied running three wide top of the lane, was no match for the winner in deep stretch but surged late securing second place in a willing manner. TRISKIN set a pressured pace traveling along the rail throughout, vied in a three way duel turning for home, yielded to the winner inside the furlong marker then was edged out of second place in last jumps in a hard effort. STARLITS LAD settled in the second flight, roused mid turn, mildly bid running along the rail improving placing but was no real threat. DON'T BLAME TEDDY rated early running towards the rear, came three to four wide upper stretch, showed belated interest but failed to factor. SOLUTIONFINDERS came in bumping ROAR OF THE SURGE at the break, settled mid pack, failed to respond when roused, traveled in the four path never threatening. ROAR OF THE SURGE was bumped and took up briefly leaving the gate, dropped off to trail, lagged throughout offering little.
