Footnotes

AVIYAH SHINES broke alertly working on a short lead through the turn, dueled inside of THE NATIVE BLAZE down the stretch finding more in the three path to prevail gamely. THE NATIVE BLAZE stalked early pressing up to threaten on the turn, bore down abreast AVIYAH SHINES through the stretch being turned away late. TOES ON THE CURB went evenly saving ground to upper stretch outbidding the others in the two path. JUSTIN A STORM tracked evenly through the turn, extending in the four path upper stretch would weaken late. PAWN SHOP QUEEN away slowly stayed back through the turn, swung seven wide in upper stretch had no surge. DANCING WONDER chased early then weakened on the turn giving way along the inside to upper stretch. MOLTO BENE remained sluggish throughout.
