Footnotes

MOVIN SOUTH raced up close early, bid between at the 1/2, dueled outside of MISS IMAGINE THAT to mid stretch, put that rival away and held firm under a drive. CALLE unhurried from gate, sat patient to far turn, asked from there, split foes at the 1/4 pole, hit stride and angled inside mid lane, made a fast gain at the wire. MISS IMAGINE THAT set a pressured pace racing off the rail throughout, battled with MOVIN SOUTH from the 3/8 pole to the 1/16 pole before ceding stubbornly, drifted out late while tiring at the wire. AMERICAN LLAVE raced in second flight early, roused mid turn, swung 4 wide top of the lane, closed gap under strong left handed pressure. ESKIMO ALY veered out leaving the gate, rushed to gain a good stalking position, made a brief bid near the 1/4 pole while racing between rivals, leveled off in the drive. LADY AFLEET rated while saving ground early, moved off rail and made a mild bid past the half racing between foes, was hard ridden into the lane but lacked needed late rally. SEXY SECRETS raced in second flight early while 5 wide, asked and gave a brief bid mid turn, weakened in upper stretch. ABSOLUTELY CITRON trailed throughout, beat a couple of weary foes in the lane, no factor. LA TINKER had speed from gate, chased for half along the inside, faded mid turn. TUFF HINT raced 4 wide into the first turn, tracked early backstretch, gave way at 1/4 pole.
