HIGH COUNTRY MISS nicely rated, raced towards the inside, advanced mid turn to race behind a trio of duelers, angled out four wide to rally, drew even a sixteenth out, led late and then had to hold off a fast closing TINK SO under strong handling. TINK SO was in tight leaving the gate when PARTY REGENT broke in, lagged and angled to the rail, saved ground throughout, angled top of the lane, hit stride and split foes mid stretch, angled towards the inside coming to the wire, finished fastest of all in a willing effort. PARTY REGENT came in at the break, rushed to race up close while three wide, vied from the quarter pole, battled to deep stretch, was out finished nearing the wire. MAGNIFICENT MISS pressed from the start, bid and vied while between foes at the quarter pole, made a slight lead mid stretch, flattened out late. DIAMOND QUEEN well placed throughout, traveled along the inside, angled under a drive top of the lane, lacked late kick. INTRIGUINGPROSPECT raced wide throughout, asked but failed to respond. PEARLS FOR DIXIE was unhurried, lagged throughout, managed to beat two weary foes, never involved. DEPUTY REALITY well placed, tracked the pace running four wide to the half, urged far turn, lacked response, weakened in the drive. QUIET HEROINE sent, set a pressured pace, was headed mid turn, dug in racing along the rail, flattered mid stretch, used up.
