MEGA WONDER broke alertly setting the pace from the two path nursing the lead through the far turn, threatened down the stretch would find more holding up gamely late. SUNDARBAN stalked the pace while saving ground looming into upper stretch, responded along the rail late bidding gamely at the end. DONT POKE THE BEAR raced evenly in the three path to the far turn, shuffled back there would swing out seven wide in upper stretch surging at the wire. GETTA RHYTHM stalked the pace racing four wide threatening into upper stretch, continued to respond going all out between horses in the closing yards. COFFEE BREAK unhurried early responded on the far turn circling out six wide to upper stretch, vied between rivals needing a final push. BARONIAL saved ground remaining a threat into upper stretch, put to stiff right hand urging would drift out late. RATHER QUICK stayed back throughout, was vanned off after the race. UNLEADED tracked the pace looming four wide through the far turn, came seven wide in upper stretch weakening there. DELONGSHOT saving ground was always outrun. NEW YORK BOBBY laid close up stalking then chasing three wide through the far turn, would wilt into upper stretch.
