Footnotes

AZSTOR slow early was circled out seven wide in upper stretch giving steady surge to clear late. SPANISH AFFAIR raced behind a trio of rivals following the pace to mid turn, angled four wide had room in upper stretch pressing late ceding to outside pressure. ANOTHER OREO was hustled out pressuring the pace wresting a short lead in the four path on the turn, working to stay in upper stretch would weaken late. IMYOURHUCKLEBERRY pressed early then dropped off the leaders on the turn, re bid six wide in upper stretch going evenly late. MATHUGHS JOURNEY was sent hard pressuring the pace inside of rivals through the turn, extended to upper stretch would gradually wear down. YES OUI SI showed early speed pursuing along the inside to upper stretch, wavered late fading on the rail. DEFIANT MOUNTAIN saving ground played no factor. LIL GREAT TOUCH was always outrun. KUFF EM broke alertly pressuring the pace from between horses through the turn then folded in upper stretch.
