Footnotes

BEN'S BULLET sat patient tracking the pace to the quarter pole, swung four to five wide entering the stretch, collared TETONS STAR mid stretch, went head to head to the finish line, won head bob on the wire being fully extended. TETON STAR stalked FORPETEYSSAKE from the start, drew even leaving the quarter pole, put a head in front upper stretch, battled inside of BEN'S BULLET from the eighth pole, alternated to the wire, lost head bob and settled for second best in a very game effort. CHARLIE'S THUNDER settled in good tracking position, mounted bid leaving the quarter pole, angled towards the rail entering the stretch, loomed mid stretch, needed a bit more late besting rest. FORPETEYSSAKE quickly showed in front, felt pressure from TETONS STAR around the bend, fought to top of the stretch, weakened at the eighth pole, drifted out slightly in deep stretch while giving way. BABA BOOEY was always outrun racing mid track, traveled five wide entering the stretch, passed weary foe late, never factored. DIAMOND ROLL flashed brief foot, chased to the quarter pole, stopped mid stretch finishing weary.
