KONA KID stalked his entry mate throughout, moved up to challenge at the three eighths pole, drove clear racing mid track entering the stretch, was kept to task increasing margin for a convincing victory. TRIPPIN' AWAY set a solid pace racing along the inside, headed by KONA KID mid turn, was no match from upper stretch, was shortening stride a sixteenth out, dug in late holding on to second place. STEPHEN'S QUEST rated early racing mid pack, rallied four wide top of the lane, closed willingly missing second place. KENNY THE SALESMAN unhurried from the gate settling towards the rear, angled entering the stretch, passed tired rivals improving placing but failed to factor. ROYAL LORD flashed brief foot, gave chase along the rail to mid turn, gave way leaving the quarter pole. ONE NICE OFFER tracked top pair down the backstretch, mildly bid mid turn, chased form the quarter pole and weakened in the drive never menacing. BEAR IS CONFIRMED was bumped from both sides shortly after the start, raced wide throughout, finished well beaten in a dull effort. SPECTACULAR TAP raced mid track traveling in the second flight, gave way midway on the second turn, finished weary.
