DOLCELINA sat 3 wide backside, bid at 3/8 pole, dueled from 3/16 to the wire and was fully extended to get the win. GLITTERING SUCCESS set pace, was nicely rated, headed entering the stretch, dueled throughout the stretch run and was easily second best. WILD SAMBA well placed, raced between horses on the turn, was asked mid turn, came up empty in the stretch drive. HIPS AND HAWS caught 6 wide into first turn, rated back down the backside, was roused into lane, made a mild gain and was no threat. MAGIC INK rated from gate, saved ground, asked mid turn, had no response and turned in an even effort. GOLDEN TOMORROW well placed, raced inside, hard ridden in stretch, weakened from the 1/4 pole to the finish. GOTTA BE A FOX hustled from gate, raced 5 wide into first turn, chased, eased to wire.
