CHUY'S CHOICE unhurried early racing far off the pace traveling mid track, made a bold four wide run midway on the second turn, continued move in the lane drew off late to win going away under a drive. RICH THUNDER sent into the first turn to gain control, set a solid opening half mile time, headed entering the stretch, battled gamely to deep stretch, proved no match for the winner but held well saving second place. JUSTICE COWBOY stalked the runner up from the start, closed in top of the lane, vied in a three way battle deep stretch, hung late vying for second place. SOCIAL WORKER raced evenly in mid pack, came five wide entering the stretch, lacked needed surge while besting rest. PAPPA SONG raced along the rail in the second flight, failed to threaten despite being hard ridden in the drive. PADDY TAP raced evenly towards the inside, lacked rally when called upon, no threat. MR. DO NICE lacked speed and raced mid track throughout, offered little. PROPER RESPECT showed good early foot, stalked the runner up to the half racing along the rail, gave way coming to the quarter pole, stopped upper stretch and was eased across the finish line. AMIGO MIO was always outrun, stopped top of the lane and was eased across the finish line.
