BRAVE ART D'OR was patiently ridden in the early going, angled three wide entering the stretch, drew even mid stretch vying in a three way battle, edged clear in deep stretch, won under a stiff drive. GHOU L raced up close along the rail from the start, angled entering the stretch, dueled racing between foes from mid stretch, matched strides to deep stretch, was outgamed in last jumps, missed in a hard effort. FOUR BOOTS broke sharply, set the pace traveling along the rail, headed from mid stretch, fought gamely to deep stretch, came up short just holding on to the show position. MEGA WONDER settled in mid pack, angled leaving the quarter pole, hit stride mid stretch, closed ground rapidly in deep stretch. MASTER COPY broke in to bump foes, raced evenly in mid pack, failed to respond when asked for more. BE BOPPIN WYNN was squeezed and took up shortly after the start, raced in the second flight, failed to factor. HE'S THE KING hustled early, raced up close to mid turn, started to fade in upper stretch, no late factor. LORE OF THE ROAD was bumped at the break, dropped off to trail early on, never factored.
