BK'S CLEARANCEISLE was well handled saving ground down the backside, angled leaving the far turn, rallied to split foes mid turn, collared JUMP TO START past the quarter pole, drove clear in upper stretch, drew off under steady handling. JUMP TO START raced up close from the start, bid for the lead leaving the far turn, headed by BK'S CLEARANCEISLE entering the stretch, was no match from the furlong marker, held well proving a game second best. MARILYN'S GUY rated early, moved to the rail entering the backside, gained nearing the half, loomed mid turn and had to check racing along the rail at the three eighths pole when in tight, lost momentum, angled past the quarter pole, tried to re-rally under a drive top of the stretch, failed to menace besting rest. GIVEN CREDIT lacked speed, roused mid turn, gave belated gain to improve placing but was no real threat. PULPIT'S JET set a pressured pace to the half, fought hard to the quarter pole, was all done mid stretch, used up. LOFTY AND NOBLE was nor far off the pace racing four to five wide to the far turn, roused on the bend, lacked response and weakened from upper stretch. YOUNG LAD stalked early on, loomed at the quarter pole racing between rivals, gave way mid stretch. STALWART KIDD was always outrun, lost contact near the quarter pole, eased in the stretch.
