Footnotes

WYO BANDITO tracked RONALDO from the start, set down leaving the quarter pole, took aim coming three wide into the stretch, drew even with a furlong to go, battled to the wire and finally inched clear in last jumps. RONALDO rushed soon after the start, dueled down the backstretch, moved clear going into the far turn, angled to the rail opening up at the quarter pole, headed by WYO BANDITO in upper stretch, fought hard to the finish but was out nodded missing in a very determined try. AMBER DUBAI lacked speed racing well off the rail down the backside, rallied five wide top of the lane, chased top pair throughout the stretch run but needed more, did however win the battle for third place. BUDDY'S SONG settled in mid pack, asked near the quarter pole, traveled in the four path from upper stretch, vied for third place late but was edged out on the wire. EL WINDO lacked speed racing towards the rear, angled out a bit upper stretch, showed belated interest but never factored. JET RAIDER tracked early on, swung our wide under urging top of the lane, passed a couple of weary foes but never factored. LINE CAMP flashed brief foot, chased to top of the stretch, gave way in upper stretch. CIHANGIR (IRE) broke alertly dueling with the runner up to the far turn, retreated leaving the quarter pole, stopped in mid stretch finishing spent.
