Footnotes

BELLA FIORE stalked the pace laying close up through the turn, bid abreast rivals three deep in upper stretch wearing down MING WIN late to win clear. MING WIN pressured E T. ANGEL on pace through the turn, joined by BELLA FORCE in upper stretch dueled between horses then with the latter late ceding grudgingly in the final yards. E. T. ANGEL broke alertly working to keep a head in front under pressure through the turn, dueling inside of rivals at the rail in upper stretch would wear down late. LEXI TAP raced evenly off the pace through the turn, hard ridden three then four wide down the lane had no late surge. QUIKDRAW BELLSTAR raced second flight through the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch raced evenly under a stiff drive. ALISSA WHO slow early swung out six wide in upper stretch proving no menace. CLARKSBURG EXPRESS was always outrun. MISS PUDDIN was squeezed and forced to steady at the break, stayed back after. GHOSTLY CHANT flashed early speed then wavered on the turn giving way along the inside.
