NELLA'S MANGAS stalked evenly through the turn, loomed abreast rivals three deep in upper stretch, drew out late in the four path. KING THOU ART veered in crowding rivals at the break, hustled to the top worked on a narrow lead through the turn, dueling along the inside down the stretch would cede the issue late. SHANNON'S BEAU slow early circled out in upper stretch bidding six then five wide improving position. SUZANNE'S FRIEND carried in at the break was hustled early dropping off on the turn, saved ground to upper stretch finishing evenly along the inside. NO PAPANAZZI squeezed back at the break played no factor. STORMY DUDE broke alertly pressuring the pace through the turn, dueled between horses in upper stretch wearing down late in the three path. OMEGA ME AMIGO a step slow early rushed up to contention on the turn, wavered in upper stretch steadying when in close near the sixteenth pole. FLYING NIGHTMARE carried in at the break was always outrun.
