Footnotes

FIRST MOVEMENT raced evenly in mid pack through the turn, angled six wide in upper stretch surged steadily arriving in time. FLATLAND FEVER sent clear set the pace through the turn, widened in the three path upper stretch then became leg weary late drifting out while ceding in the final yards. ANNIKA'S LOVE a step slow early came seven wide in upper stretch, bid evenly the final eighth improving position. SIRR PURR stumbled at the break, stayed back through the turn, gained along the inside in upper stretch then angled to mid track late. POWERHOUSE away slowly was outrun through the turn, raced three and four wide down the lane finishing evenly. GO GO MOJO raced evenly while saving ground through the turn, tired in the two path the final eighth. FLASH JORDAN chased close up through the turn, gave way while drifting out down the stretch. BRITELUCK was always outrun. YULETIDE showed little.
