Footnotes

HABASAC pressed the pace from the start, vied in a four way battle top of the lane, put a head in front in mid stretch, dug in coming to the wire prevailing in a very determined effort. WAR TALK settled towards the rear traveling mid track, gained mid turn, split foes turning for home racing in the four path, drew even with the winner with fifty yards to go but was denied missing in a very game effort. HEZA BELFAST tracked along the rail from the start, rallied almost drawing even with the winner in mid stretch, failed to sustain rally and tired late saving third place. BENBAD settled towards the rear, swung out five wide upper stretch, gave belated action finishing with interest. GHOST KISSER raced in mid pack to the quarter pole, advanced top of the lane to loom off of duellers, threatened to mid stretch then flattened out missing a minor award. HESA ARKY well placed from the start, bid three wide racing between foes entering the stretch, lacked needed surge. SHORTYS FASHION was hard used setting a pressured pace running along the rail, fought gamely to upper stretch, gave way in the final furlong, used up. MIXED SIGNALS lacked speed running towards the rear throughout, angled wide upper stretch under a drive, failed to respond never factoring. NEVER FIGHT MONEY was always outrun, never involved.
