EFFERVESCENT CHARM laid close up, wrested the lead in the four path upper stretch, dug in late holding gamely. PRINCEOFTHESTORMYC was hustled in pursuit through the turn, bid mid track upper stretch, drifted in late saving place. CONNOISSEUR broke sharply, hustled on lead through the turn, headed upper stretch would weaken. DARCY BOY chased on the inside through the turn, extended down upper stretch near the rail weakened late. ALRIGHT NOW slow early played no factor. HYRULE bumped at the break was hurried through the turn, wore out wide in upper stretch. MAKE A WESH was always outrun. BLUE RODEO chased early then gave way on the turn. MR GUSKA lost ground, tired in upper stretch. STRICKS CHAIRMAN labored throughout.
