Footnotes

MEEK MAN rushed to the front, cleared early and angled towards the inside, headed by FRESH CUT at the quarter pole, turned that rival away in upper stretch, was kept to pressure holding safe at the finish. BREAKING FREE broke alertly and angled to the rail, stalked the winner saving ground, angled to the four path in upper stretch, surged late missing in a good effort. COPY THOSE NOTES settled towards the rear, angled out under left handed stick in upper stretch, was trying to split foes late, raced a bit in close finishing with good energy. CANDELAGRASGOODBOY well placed early, raced between foes mid turn, angled out five wide top of the lane, vied for a minor award but was outgamed in last jumps. FRESH CUT rushed hard shortly after the start, almost drew even with the winner at the quarter pole, was turned away by mid stretch weakening in the last furlong. REGAL GROUND tracked around the bend racing four wide, gave chase from the quarter pole, lacked response never threatening the lane. DAY ROAD settled in the second flight, raced inside throughout, failed to respond, no factor. BAD ECONOMY was always outrun, never factored. LUCK AND LIES hustled early, raced wide losing ground around the turn, faded top of the stretch.
