GAMBLING DON prompted the pace traveling in the three path, moved for the lead mid turn, battled in a three way duel at the three eighths, drove clear entering the stretch, widened from mid stretch winning with authority being ridden out. SHOOTMETOTHEMOON settled running mid pack, rallied three wide from the quarter pole, chased the winner throughout the stretch, failed to threaten while holding second place. WARRIOR'S HIT raced up close along the rail, bid for the lead mid turn, vied briefly in a three way duel, dropped off at the quarter pole, swung four wide upper stretch coming again, finished willing getting the nod for third place. DOWNTOWN DRIGGS unhurried in the early stages, moved strongly entering the stretch racing five wide, vied abreast foes mid stretch for a minor award, hung late missing third place. STRONG BRUSH set a rated pace from the start traveling a bit off the rail, headed from both sides at the three eighths, battled to the quarter pole, was all done upper stretch, faded to the wire. DATE A SAINT raced four wide into the first turn, remained wide down the backside racing in mid pack, roused leaving the far turn, failed to respond, no threat. TURF ELITE lacked speed running towards the rear, raced wide entering the stretch under a drive, offered little. CRUZINGINTHESTORM flashed brief speed, retreated from the half finishing well beaten. RAY FROM CLAY was quickly outrun, pulled up mid stretch, rider dismounted and was vanned off.
