**Footnotes**

AVOID broke alertly moving on a quick pace through the turn, shook clear in the four path upper stretch then held on when a bit weary nearing the wire. SURFACTANT slow early circled out to upper stretch, responded in the seven path bidding gamely late. PETECAROL slow early saved ground to upper stretch, put to a stiff drive angled to the three path pressing wider rivals late. FATHER'S MIG chased the pace edging closer to threaten on the turn, extending at mid track from the eighth pole would hang late. HENDERSON hustled along moved to contention on the turn, raced six wide in upper stretch needing a late surge. MISSISSIPPI HIPPIE pressured early then gave way on the turn.
