MEGIDDO set a well rated pace traveling in the two path, pressured by FUNNYSTORI thru the turn, angled over to the rail in upper stretch, headed by NORTHERN LUCK in mid stretch and lost the lead briefly, came again taking control late and was edging away at the finish. NORTHERN LUCK taken in hand leaving the gate, asked for more leaving the far turn, rallied three wide into the lane, moved abreast MEGIDDO in mid stretch and actually put a head in front, raced together to the wire but was outfinished and settled for second best. SWINGING CHANGO lagged for six furlongs, angled to the rail entering the stretch, found stride and closed belatedly picking up the show position. FUNNYSTORI pressed the winner racing along the rail to midway on the second turn, had to angle out top of the lane when MEGIDDO angled sharply to the rail, gave chase under urging but failed to menace and weakened being edged out of third place. GOTTA RUNAWAY stalked early on traveling three wide down the backside, began to tire upper stretch drifting out four to five wide, no late factor. FABULOUS FRED well placed running between foes to the far turn, began to fade leaving the quarter pole, no factor. BELL FLOP lacked speed running at mid track, gave way finishing well beaten.
