**Footnotes**

COLLEGEVILLE KID broke alertly, sat patient racing for the lead from the four path, asked for more entering the stretch under strong left handed stick, responded to draw off for a convincing victory. QUICK TRICK showed good speed, vied inside of COLLEGEVILLE KID going down the backside, could not keep up leaving the furlong marker, held on gamely to save the place position in a sold effort. SCATARAD raced up near the pace from the start, vied briefly entering the stretch, was no late threat despite being under sever pressure, held show in a willing manner. GOOD VERSUS BAD well placed, tracked a contested pace saving ground throughout, angled to split foes upper stretch, came up empty in the drive to the wire. LIVELY EXIT raced evenly towards the inside, hard ridden top of the lane, drifted very wide during the stretch run, failed to menace. DAMOOSCUS swerved out at the start, settled racing wide down the backside, continued wide throughout, found best stride too late, finished with interest but was no threat. GREAT ALBERT lacked speed, moved out very wide going down the backside, failed to factor. NESTASKO raced mid pack under urging, weakened upper stretch. WHIPCRACKAWAY raced mid pack briefly, traveled off the rail, faded leaving the quarter pole, no factor.
