Footnotes

NIMBLE TIGER settled racing off the rail, roused at the quarter pole, swung six wide into the stretch, drew even at the eighth pole, surged clear then drifted in coming to the wire. TRASH TO TREASURE raced up close from the start, bid mid turn, vied entering the stretch running between foes, proved no match for the winner in deep stretch but dug in gamely holding on to second place. RANGER ROB well placed sitting off a hotly contested pace, moved out four wide mounting rally entering the stretch, drew even mid stretch, lightly brushed with NIMBLE TIGER at the sixteenth pole, was outfinished late and settled for third best. THE RIDER OF RANGER ROB CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OD NIMBLE TIGER CITING INTERFERENCE NEAR THE SIXTEENTH POLE, AFTER REVIEW, THIS CLAIM WAS DISMISSED. POORTOWN RULER was slow into stride, raced mid track around the bend, came five to six wide entering the stretch, did respond late narrowing the gap but was no real threat. MIRACLE CREEK lacked speed racing towards the rear, angled a bit in upper stretch, mildly bid in deep stretch but never menaced. NEWYORKJOE quickly showed in front, was soon pressured going around the bend, fought hard to mid stretch, faltered at the sixteenth pole running along the rail. HOMERSRUN swerved in sharply and was taken up leaving the gate, trailed to mid stretch, went by weary foe late, never involved. BIGBADBARNEY showed good speed, pressed for the lead to the quarter pole running between rivals, had nothing left by mid stretch, gave way finishing spent.
