Footnotes

DOLCE LUSSO unhurried early responded out of the far turn emerging to threaten from mid track, found best stride late surging clear in the closing yards. MEMPHIS SUNRISE prompted the pace drifting out into the backside, worked to lead through the far turn into upper stretch, angled in from the four path to the two slot while being overpowered late. CITY STRIKE tracked early edging closer on the backside, fired along the rail dueling in upper stretch, gradually wore down the final sixteenth. KOKO KEY went evenly off the pace through the backside, gave a mild move along the inside in upper stretch then angled to the three path proving no late menace. ROCKY CAFE slow early raced five and six wide down the stretch as no menace. SILENT HONOR stalked the pace through the backside then wavered on the far turn dropping from contention into upper stretch. WOODYS A GOODIE was always outrun. KUFF EM pressured the pace while being held out five wide into the backside, moved in tandem with MEMPHIS SUNRISE as the pair dueled to the far turn, weakened there giving way near mid track in upper stretch. SIR RAYFORD was steadied briefly entering the first turn, stayed back after giving no response.
