NOT ANY PRICE prompted the pace through the backside into the far turn, put a head in front near the quarter pole edging clear into upper stretch, digging in late held on gamely in the three path. EL PATRONE away slowly was outrun through the far turn, began to respond in upper stretch angling to the four path pressing the winner hard at the end. FLAG INDY slow early stayed back through the far turn, gained in the three path upper stretch threatening needing a final surge. CENTENNIAL'S SONG stalked close up through the far turn, angled out to mid track would weaken the final eighth. LINCE PRIETO prompted the pace through the far turn, wavered in upper stretch fading in the two path. MCBEAN was always outrun. L'S LEGACY raced evenly through the backside then flattened out on the far turn.
