Footnotes

SMART EXPLOITS was nicely rated, sat patient to the far turn, quickly gained nearing the quarter pole, cleared entering the stretch, drew off being ridden out as much the best. MISS MALAKIA rated early on, raced along the rail to top of the stretch, angled out upper stretch, finished willingly proving second best but never threatened the winner. VERRE raced up close from the start, traveled along the rail throughout, moved for the lead leaving the far turn, put a head in front mid turn, collared by the winner past the quarter pole, proved no match and weakened inside the eighth pole holding on to third place. NOMUDDERAFLEET stalked running three to four wide down the backside, began to chase under urging mid turn, started to fade entering the stretch, no factor in the lane. SELFLESSNESS was forwardly placed racing four wide to the half, remained a threat to the quarter pole, had nothing left by mid stretch giving way. DOLL LURE set a pressured pace throughout traveling a little off the rail, headed from both sides mid turn, gave way mid stretch, used up. KENTUCKY KITTY was quickly outrun, never factored in a dull effort.
