GO GO MOJO was bumped at the break, stalked early firing clear on the far turn, dug in through the stretch holding firm. ACTING OUT was well rated, rallied on the far turn, loomed off GO GO MOJO from the eighth pole making no headway under stiff urging. ASHOTOFJACKANABEER slow early advanced on the far turn, circled out six wide to upper stretch, gave even action the last eighth holding the others. MIGHTY HIGH laid close up, stalked to the far turn then weakened in drive. STRIKE TWO prompted early, chased to the half then dropped off on far turn. FREIGHT TRAIN bumped at the break played no factor. OLYMPUS was bumped and steadied at the break, dropped well back early never reaching contention. KICKEN N SCREAMING sent to top was worked on pace then wore out. RANDY DANDY was always outrun. SHARKEY'S SHARK raced mid pack before flattening out.
