**Footnotes**

CIRCLINGWEND made a steady advance down the backside, dueled at the half racing three wide, moved clear coming to the quarter pole, held DAD'S GIRL safe to the finish under strong urging. DAD'S GIRL rated early racing mid pack, rallied four wide mid turn, loomed off the winner at the quarter pole, was turned away nearing the wire, missed in a very good try. INSIDE THE PEARL settled in the second flight, swung five wide top of the stretch, surged belatedly getting up for third place. BALLET ROUSSE forwardly placed down the backside, advanced splitting rivals at the quarter pole, moved towards the inside mid stretch, needed more late leveling off. HAVEANICEFADAAY settled in the second flight, raced five wide under a drive at the quarter pole, mildly bid improving placing but never menaced. LEXI TAP lagged for six furlongs, came six wide top of the stretch, showed belated interest improving position but never threatened. JAZZY GIRL vied briefly, was taken back to stalk, bid along the rail mid turn almost drawing even for the lead, began to weaken top of the stretch, no late factor. CHIPOFFTHEOLDROCK was off slowly, raced inside down the backside, offered little. BELLA SOUND varied little racing towards the rear, showed little. ALWAYS SOMETHING sent into the first turn, set a pressured pace, headed from both sides at the quarter pole, had nothing left in upper stretch and stopped at the eighth pole, used up.
