PLUMLAKE LADY set all the pace racing off the rail, put away TONI DENITTO leaving the far turn, asked for more near the 1/4 pole, responded nicely to increase margin in upper stretch, won convincingly under a drive to the finish. LUNES GRITO tracked down the backside racing 4 wide, roused mid turn, rallied into the lane, never threatened the winner but proved a game second best. VICTORIOUS HALO hustled and stalked PLUMLAKE LADY going down the backside while racing inside, asked mid turn and angled to mid track, chased between foes top of the stretch, failed to rally and tired from mid stretch. SEA DOVE was rated early, raced towards the inside, gained mid turn and chased under a drive top of the stretch, vied for the place position in upper stretch, flattened out near the eighth pole. PYRITE RAIN was hustled and tracked early while running off the rail, faded after a half, no factor. TONI DENITTO broke outward, was quickly rushed to stalk PLUMLAKE LADY going to the half, was all done by mid turn, no factor.
