Footnotes

REVIVAL was well handled in the early stages, angled out entering the stretch, bid six wide top of the lane, brushed with GONE GRAND late while that rival was drifting out, edged clear late under a stiff drive. MASHARKA stalked throughout, angled out mid stretch, split foes and surged willingly coming to the wire, game effort. LIR JET showed sharp speed taking the lead, pressured at the quarter pole, drifted wide mid stretch while beginning to tire, was out finished late just holding on to third place. MY STREET was off slowly and trailed for the opening strides, advanced mid turn, raced seven wide top of the lane, drifted inward mid stretch, finished strongly nearing the wire but was no real threat. MIKES MONSTER settled in the second flight, angled to the rail mid turn, surged in deep stretch finishing with interest. COILED INTHE HEART was forwardly placed, loomed at the quarter pole, remained a threat to mid stretch, lacked needed surge. GONE GRAND stalked the moved up vying for the lead top of the lane, put to strong left handed stick and drifted out mid stretch brushing with the winner, weakened late. KINKY RULE raced in good tracking position, lost position on the turn, angled towards the inside in upper stretch, was forced to check sharply when MY STREET angled in mid stretch, no late threat. GOOD SAMARITAN trailed early never factoring. BLUE RODEO lacked speed racing along the inside, offered little.
