MEISTERWERK well handled early, sat patient to the quarter pole, angled four wide making move entering the stretch, collared ALRIGHT NOW mid stretch, slowly edged away late under strong urging. ALRIGHT NOW rated early, rallied three wide on the bend, took the lead turning for home, headed by the winner mid stretch, matched strides to deep stretch, was outfinished late proving a game second best. KWAME unhurried early, roused mid turn, angled to the rail mid stretch, surged willingly grabbing the show position. DREAMINGOFTHESALE lagged to midway on the turn, advanced running along the rail, angled out abruptly mid stretch for room, needed more late. JAYGAR DANCER well placed racing mid track, mildly bid on the turn, loomed briefly, leveled off in the drive. INHERITANCE LOST hustled from the gate, raced four wide into the first turn, vied running two to three wide for six furlongs, had enough and gave way mid stretch. HIGH ACT hustled and set a pressured pace running along the rail for six furlongs, had little left entering the stretch, finished spent. FIDDLERS JINGO pressed for the lead to the half, faded at the quarter pole, stopped top of the stretch, finished weary.
